UnityPoint Health potentially leaving Amerigroup network

It was announced last week that UnityPoint Health may end their participation in the Amerigroup Iowa provider network. This change would become effective January 1, 2018.

UnityPoint Health continues discussions with Amerigroup to reach an agreement by the end of the year. UnityPoint Health remains a network provider for UnitedHealthcare.

Medicaid members who have coverage through Amerigroup may want to take this into consideration and switch to United Healthcare Plan of the River Valley, Inc.

AmeriHealth Caritas Iowa, Inc. no longer MCO Provider

All Medicaid members currently enrolled with AmeriHealth Caritas Iowa, Inc. have been notified that they will be tentatively assigned to UnitedHealthcare Plan of the River Valley, Inc. effective December 1, 2017, unless the member chooses to change enrollment to Amerigroup Iowa, Inc.

If the member wishes to change enrollment to Amerigroup Iowa, Inc, they may for any reason until March 1, 2018. But switching should be looked at very carefully, with the potential of UnityPoint not taking Amerigroup MCO.
